Admission Requirements:

- Completion of **Intro to Psychology / General Psychology** course is a prerequisite for counseling program
- Minimum of 45 transferable hours preferred (*we will work with applicants who desire to enter the program but lack the necessary hours by helping them pursue credit from previous experience or work-related training or through college-level exams*).
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better
- Minimum age of 20 for active participants in the program
- Simplified application forms and verifications
- Official transcripts from any previous college-level coursework, high school, and/or GED
